CELL PHONES

TAKING YOUR DAUGHTER OFF CAMPUS

- It is not necessary to take your daughter off campus. However, if you choose to leave for a short while have her check out with the O.D. No camper is allowed out except with her own parents or relatives unless the Director has received written notification to the contrary.
- Our camp policy is that campers stay on campus and do not spend the night off campus unless on a camp trip. It
 can become disruptive if parents take their daughters away for the night. Thanks for your cooperation with this
 policy.

KEEWAYDIN TIME

The times listed above are Eastern <u>Daylight</u> Savings time. We will <u>not</u> be on Keewaydin camp time at mid-season.

SWIMMING

You are welcome to swim at our swim dock at designated times only. Be sure to check with the Lifeguard on duty there. (There is <u>no</u> swimming during rest hour or after the lifeguards declare the swim period closed to campers and family members.) Please discuss any siblings' swimming abilities with the Lifeguard before they swim.

BOATS OUT

You are welcome to participate in Boats Out (Saturday afternoon after activities) with your daughter, and we'd love to have you do this. All participants must wear a <u>zipped</u> Personal Flotation Device (PFD) while in any boat and stay within the designated portion of the lake. Please help us enforce these important safety rules.

DOGS

If you absolutely must bring your dog, please keep him/her on a leash or leave him/her in the car. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!! We recommend that you consider having your dog go to "doggy day care" on Saturday, July 20 We recommend Middlebury Kennel (802-388-9643). They charge \$15 for the day. They appreciate a call ahead of time. Ellen's dog, Koko, goes there all winter and loves it. They really do "treat your pet like family."

PLEASE: NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON CAMPUS!

PLEASE: NO SMOKING ON CAMPUS! We are a **smoke-free** environment so please refrain from smoking anywhere on campus while at camp. Only campfires may smoke at camp.

SUNDAY MORNING

Parents of 8 week campers:

- Please do not plan on taking your daughter out on Sunday morning. You may come to say good-bye and have a final <u>brief</u> visit after breakfast (for campers and staff only) at about 9:15 AM. Please wait on the Manor House porch, at Beenadeewin or in the Longhouse areas until breakfast is over.
- Plan to leave by 10:00 AM at the latest. Bell will call all campers and staff to Circle. (You can also have your final good-byes on Saturday after the campfire. This may allow you to get an earlier start traveling Sunday morning.)

Parents of 4 week campers:

- After breakfast ends at about 9:15 AM, use our western entrance and collect your daughter from her Longhouse. Carts will be available for moving luggage to cars.
- When ready to leave camp, parents and campers together should stop at the Registration Table at Beenadeewin. Pick-up camper Going-Home pack and complete final check out. The Going-Home packet contains medications, a passport and other important items.
- Now is when you can retrieve your daughter's cell phone which will also be in the Going-Home packet.
- Campers leaving Sunday with their parents should be on their way by 10:00 AM
