Keewaydin Camp was founded in 1893 and is the oldest continually operating canoe tripping camp in North America. Located on a majestic 50 acre island, in the traditional territory of the Temagami Anishinabai people, surrounded by the pristine water of Lake Temagami. Our single gender program with campers ranging in age from 10-18 years old, participate in 5, 10, 21 day, and longer canoe trips. Our staff and community is kind, caring, and believe deeply in the opportunities and growth of our tripping program for kids. Campers have minimal in camp time, the majority of their experience is out canoeing and camping. When in camp, campers and staff may need medical support or a check in. When on their trips, if needed, a consultation with medical staff could be requested.

The position includes a competitive salary, room and board, with comfortable accommodations, access to canoes, kayaks, and paddle boards. Our location provides many comforts yet is a rustic and beautiful location.

**The Opportunity:** *In partnership with our other medical staff.*

- Setting up and maintaining an infirmary to provide health care to campers and staff.
- Responsible for the care, safety, storage and inventory of all medical equipment.
- Provides health care such as emergency care, and first aid to all campers and staff.
- Maintains health records of all those who visit the camp infirmary.
- Responsible for communicating camper health issues with Camp Director.
- Reviews pre-camp health forms of campers and staff.
- Provides leadership in issues of health care to counseling and resource staff.
- Refill trip med kits as needed.

- Ability to manage health forms and paper work
- Enjoy working with kids 10-18

- Hard-working, enthusiastic and committed to the safety and well-being of campers
- Adaptable and comfortable interacting positively with other camp staff

- Friendly, happy with a good sense of humour
- Ability to make decisions and take initiative
- Flexibility regarding working hours.
