Registration House: Please plan your arrival at Keewaydin during the following hours:

- ✓ Thursday: 3:00 – 5:00
- ✓ Friday: 9:00 – 4:00
- ✓ Saturday: 9:00 – 3:00

Parking: Please park in the “Mountain Lot,” the large parking lot on Rt 53 across from the camp (the first parking lot AFTER the overhead bridge). If you have mobility issues, please park in the back Campus Lot off of Keewaydin Way.

Registration: Registration will be held on the front porch of the Dining Hall. Please register before you load in your gear! We will have staff on hand to help you with your gear, AFTER you have registered.

Apparel: Late August is generally a gorgeous time of the year-warm, sunny days and cool nights. Hopefully, we'll be in shorts and short sleeves during the day, but you will **definitely want a few layers to wear at night.** Dress is always casual!
