**MEALS:** On Saturday we will have an outdoor lunch buffet at 12:30 p.m. and a Chicken Barbecue outdoor picnic for dinner at 6:00 p.m. Both of these meals are for campers and parents.

If you have a son at Keewaydin and daughter at Songadeewin and would like to share some family time together between both campuses, we invite you to bring your son to Songa for lunch and your daughter to Keewaydin for dinner. Boys need to be back at Keewaydin by 1:45 p.m. and girls back at Songa by 7:15 p.m.

Coffee and tea are available all day in the Dining Hall. Please: no alcoholic beverages at camp. Please also refrain from smoking or vaping; we are a tobacco free campus.

**SUNDAY MORNING:** The last event of Mid-Season Weekend is Sunday Circle. This takes place at the Wiantinaug Circle. After Sunday Circle (approximately 10:30 a.m.), we will say our good-byes to first month campers and staff will help campers get their luggage to cars.

**SWIMMING:** You are welcome to swim at a Grove dock at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 20, but be sure to check with the O.D. there. (There is no swimming during rest hour). "Ladies Beach" is also available for swimming and a lifeguard will be on duty at various times throughout the day.

**BOATS OUT:** Parents may go in canoes or rowboats with their sons on Saturday afternoon after swim. Sailboats and kayaks are not available. If you go in a boat, you must wear a PFD and stay in Keewaydin's waterfront area.

**DOGS:** We encourage you to leave your dog at home, but if you need to bring your dog, please keep him/her on a leash or leave him/her in the car and please clean up after him/her!
